Task 1 English Take your teddy with you when you are on a visit in and around our local area. Write a postcard to a friend or family member describing your day out.	Task 2 Maths Collect 10 objects from your house. How many different ways can you group them? e.g. Hard/soft, shiny/dull, metal/non-metal. Record your findings in your book.	Task 3 DT Build a landmark in Battersea using Lego, blocks or 3-D junk material from home.	Task 4 Geography Go on a walk with an adult. Can you draw a map of where you went? Draw pictures of objects/buildings that you see on your route. 	Task 5 RHE Choose a zoo animal that is visiting John Burns School. Can you write some rules for it to follow to help them become a John Burns pupil?
Task 6 Science Battersea park is on the South Bank of the River Thames. Create a boat that would be able to float for at least 2 minutes. What will you make it out of? Take photographs or bring in your boat to demonstrate to the class.	Task 7 Art Draw a cityscape of London. Which landmarks have you included? Which is your favourite?	Task 8 History Discuss with an adult at home how Battersea has changed since they were little or first came to Battersea. What has changed since you went to school? Has anything stayed the same? What toys did you play with? Where did you go to play?	Task 9 Computing Using a non fiction book, or by accessing a computer with an adult, find images of different cities around the world that you are interested in. Can you find and record a short fact about each city?	Task 10 Maths Practise counting forwards and backwards to 100. Can you say what is one more or one less than a number? Your challenge is to count in groups of 2s and 5s also.
